The Presenters:

Dr Philip Marazzi has been a partner in the East Horsley Medical Practice since 1991. In a recent East Horsley Church Magazine he wrote *"With an increasingly frail elderly population to look after, we are constantly trying to find ways of keeping our patients fit and independent"*.

Callum Russell works at 'Sight for Surrey' as a Fund Raiser and Events Administrator. He has been blind from birth and in his talk will cover problems caused by gradual deterioration of sight.

Mike Turnill was born deaf in his left ear. With decreasing hearing in the right ear he faced challenges throughout his life – in education and at work, leading him to become involved with a hearing charity. He became a Trustee of Hearing Link in January 2011, but started working at the charity as a volunteer in 2009, focusing on improving their IT systems so that the charity could improve their services.

It was in this role that he became involved with the U3A, trying the help U3As to tackle the problems of hearing loss.

Mary Baker, MBE, is President of the European Brain Council, immediate past President of the European Federation of Neurological Associations, Consultant to the World Health Organisation (WHO) and Chair of the Working Group on Parkinson's Disease formed by the WHO in May 1997. A Patron of the European Parkinson's Disease Association (EPDA) and the former past President of EPDA, Mary served as Chief Executive of the Parkinson's Disease Society of the United Kingdom for 18 years.

Stuart Haythorn is the Area Service Manager for the Institute of Advanced Motoring ROADSMART. In addition to talking about maintaining safe driving skills, he will explain an evaluation service available to those wishing to assess their ability to continue driving.

Maria Bayley - Being hearing impaired has not stopped Maria from participating in a hearing world. She is: a lip reading teacher; visiting lecturer at Roehampton University; a Trustee of her professional association; helps spread knowledge and understanding about cochlear implants through voluntary work with Cochlear Europe Limited; and provides hearing awareness training and talks to a diverse range of audiences.

How to find East Horsley Village Hall, Kingston Avenue, E. Horsley KT24 6QT:

By Car

From the A3 northbound

Leave the A3 at Ripley. Drive through the village and at the roundabout to rejoin the A3 take the second exit towards Ockham Road North/B2039. Continue along the B2039, Ockham Road North, for about 2.8 miles through Ockham into East Horsley. Immediately after passing through the railway arch turn **Right** into Kingston Avenue beside Budgens. Follow Kingston Avenue to the end and you will find East Horsley Village Hall and car park.

From the A3 southbound

Leave the A3 at the B2039/B2215 exit towards Ockham/Ripley/Send/A247. At the roundabout take the first exit towards Ockham Road North/B2039. Continue along the B2039, Ockham Road North, for about 2.8 miles through Ockham into East Horsley. Immediately after passing through the railway arch turn **Right** into Kingston Avenue beside Budgens. Follow Kingston Avenue to the end and you will find East Horsley Village Hall and car park.

From the A246

Take the exit onto Ockham Road South/B2039. Slight left to stay on Ockham Road South/B2039. On entering East Horsley village pass the Bishopsmead Parade shops and turn left onto Kingston Avenue immediately after Budgens. Follow Kingston Avenue to the end and you will find East Horsley Village Hall and car park.

By Bus

From Guildford take the 478 which stops adjacent to Station Approach.

By Train

Walk down from Horsley Station and cross Ockham Road South. You will see Kingston Avenue ahead of you. Follow Kingston Avenue to the end (past the Doctor's Surgery) and you will find East Horsley Village Hall and car park.
