## All Change! Avant-Garde Art in the First-Half of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century

Traditionally art has reflected the culture of which it is part, but in the Modern Period, art movements have sought to change that culture. This study day will look at four movements which have attempted to change radically both the world itself and our way of thinking about it.

- 10.00 **Burn the Gondolas!** Italian Futurism launched in 1909, an artistic and social movement inspired by markers of modernity such as industrial cities, speed and flight

- 11.30 **A Brave New World:** Russian Constructivism (1913 – late 1930's) with key artists such as Tatlin and Rodchenko
- 12.30 Lunch (Bring your own)
- 13.30 **Stop Making Sense!** Dada – a movement started in Zurich during World War 1

- 15.00 **The Poetics of the Dream:** Surrealism – a movement influenced by Sigmund Freud with major artists including Miro, Dali, Ernst and Magritte
